Ambassador Freeman is currently, inter alia, a trustee of the Carnegie Endowment for International Peace and chairman of the Committee for the Republic. He is also a former president of the Middle East Policy Council, co-chair of the U.S. China Policy Foundation, vice-chair of the Atlantic Council, trustee of the Institute for Defense Analyses, director of the Pacific Pension Institute, and member of the International Advisory Board of China National Offshore Oil Co. Ltd. ("CNOOC").

He speaks fluent Chinese, French, Spanish and conversational Arabic. Mr. Freeman is the recipient of two Distinguished Public Service Awards, three Presidential Meritorious Service Awards, a Distinguished Honor Award, and the Order of 'Abd Al-'Aziz, 1st Class, from Saudi Arabia. Ambassador Freeman was a Distinguished Fellow of the United States Institute of Peace from 1994 to 1995.

Freeman is a much sought-after speaker on foreign policy and the author of three books on the subject, "Arts of Power: Statecraft and Diplomacy," "The Diplomat's Dictionary," and "America's Misadventures in the Middle East." He attended the National Autonomous University of Mexico, received his A.B. from Yale University and a J.D. from the Harvard Law School.
